

Our aims...

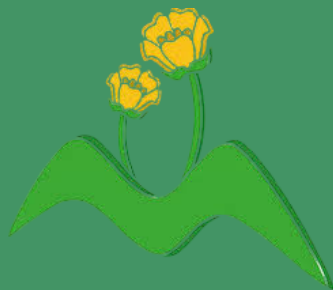

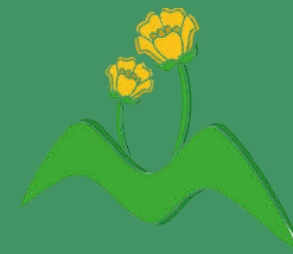
